Most of the time I've been developing the brand new widget: wrote code + tests. The initial project, written in vanilla JavaScript, was full of code couplings and tricky staff, so it was a great time for developing Sherlock's intuition. Alongside I had the opportunity to work with the backend side, videoly chrome extension, Sentry and Browserstack.

- Completely rebuild widget from native JS into TS / Web Components / Inversify
- Developed client API which allow multiple widgets + unlimited views customization
- Revamped 4 webpack configs from zero: decreased bundle size, fixed tree-shaking
- Moved wistia player into separate repo with state machine wrapper and reduced main widget bundle by 20Kb player size
- Refactored all unit/integration tests + fix e2e tests
- Fixed numerous of tricky bugs: monkey patchings, iframe bugs, heartbeat metrics, etc
- Made widget presentation for 25 colleagues to share knowledge among teams
